

Orrin Hatch, GOP candidate for the U.S. Senate, pledged to support a coordinated nationwide attack on pornography.

"Pornography is insidious and it hurts communities where people want to raise families," he said. "Local law enforcement agencies should be able to get help from the national level in order to fight it."

Hatch said local groups should be able to set their standards without interference from the federal government, but that they should be able to get guidance on how to fight it from a federal clearinghouse.

He announced two additions to his campaign staff: Alex Hurtado of Ogden as director of special groups, and Vernon Law, a BYU instructor, as chairman of people.
